Reduce the spread of COVID-19

This room has... **a portable air cleaner**



- ✓ It filters COVID-19 and other particles out of the air
- ✓ Air goes in the front or sides. Clean air comes out of the top

What you can do

- ✓ **Open windows and doors**
- ✓ Keep the air cleaner on **high**. But if it is noisy, you can turn it down, or turn it off for a short time
- ✓ **Keep it on** for 2 hours after people leave the room
- ✓ **Keep it on** when you use an air conditioner
- ✗ **Don't move it!** It is in the best position *
- ✗ Don't put anything on it or cover it!
- ! Careful! —it might be turned on even when it makes no noise.

* **Best position:** near a wall or corner, in a 'dead spot' away from doors, windows or vents; near HVAC 'supply' vents where fresh air enters the room; away from people's chairs and beds; with space for airflow at the back; so that the cord and the unit are not trip hazards, where water can't spill on it and where objects won't be put onto it.
